Science Express - Biodiversity Special (SEBS), is a collaborative initiative of Dept. of Science & Technology (DST) and Ministry of Environment & Forests (MoEF), Govt. of India, coordinated by Vikram A Sarabhai Community Science Centre (VASCSC). It is a unique science exhibition focusing on biodiversity and climate change, mounted on a customized 16 coach AC train.

With over 94 lakh visitors at its 301 halts since its launch in October 2007, Science Express is now the largest, longest and most visited mobile science exhibition in India. In its current phase from 9 April to 28 October 2013, SEBS 2013 will travel to 62 locations across India. The state-of-the-art exhibition aboard the SEBS aims to create awareness about the biodiversity of India, climate change and similar issues among students, teachers and the general public. 
