Science Express Climate Action Special (SECAS) is a collaborative initiative of Dept. of Science & Technology, Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change, Dept. of Biotechnology, Ministry of Railways, Govt. of India; Wildlife Institute of India and Vikram A Sarabhai Community Science Centre. It is a unique exhibition mounted on a customized 16 coach AC train, focusing on Climate Change and Science & Technology.

With over 1.64 crore visitors at its 495 halts since its launch in Oct 2007, Science Express is now the largest, longest running and most visited mobile science exhibition.
